SCOPE: ALS, CCT	
MEDICATION:	FUROSEMIDE (Lasix)
INTERVENTION:	Classification: Loop Diuretic
	Actions: Blocks the absorption of sodium and chloride in the kidney tubules (proximal and distal, and loop of Henle), causing a profound increase in urine output
	Contraindications: • Hypersensitivity • Anuria
	Precautions:
	Concentration:10mg/ml
	Dosage: I. Acute Decompensated Heart Failure with Pulmonary Edema: a. Adult: i. IV/IO: 40 mg x 1 b. Pediatric: i. Consult Medical Control
	Onset of Action: IV: 5 minutes
	<u>Duration</u> : IV: 2 hours
	Adverse Effects: Hypokalemia, electrolyte imbalance, hypovolemia, ototoxicity, thrombosis, urinary frequency, dizziness, nausea/vomiting, weakness, muscle cramps, hypokalemia, hypomagnesemia, blurred vision, abdominal cramps
